

BIOGRAPHY FOR MUFULUKYE FRED

- **Mr. Mufulukye Fred** is the Director General of National Rehabilitation Service since April 2021.
Fred has previously served in different capacities in Rwanda's institutions including, Governor of Eastern Province from Sept 2017 to March 2021; Director General of Territorial Administration and Good Governance, Ministry of Local Government, from May 2010 to Sept 2017. He has also held different positions in the ministry of local government including coordination of policy formulation, capacity building interventions, and monitoring and evaluation of local government authorities; Personal Assistant to the Minister of Local Government.
- Mr. Fred Mufulukye holds a Master's Degree in Public Policy and Management from the Institute of Social Studies (ISS), The Netherlands. He has a Bachelors Degree in Public Administration from the National University of Rwanda. Mr. Fred has had a number of leadership trainings in Africa, USA, Europe and Singapore. He is one of the fellows for Archbishop Tutu Fellowship Program and US-International Visitors Leadership Program.
- As a consultant, Fred designed Rwanda's change management framework for Vision 2020-Umurenge programme, evaluated decentralisation policy 1st phase. He is one of the Rwanda Trainers for Local Leaders on good governance, values in action and development.
- Fred actively participated in governance reforms in the post genocide Rwanda especially in areas of decentralisation, democratisation and local rapid development. He was an active player in the 2006 Rwanda Territorial Administrative reform as well as designing new performance approach (Imihigo).
